HER Rejuvenator

A rejuvenator is not a product that sits on the top of an existing oxidised surface and does little more than offer a sacrificial layer to the oxidising effects.

A true rejuvenator chemically revitalises the lighter molecular compounds and reconstructs the balance in the bitumen surface to become flexible again.

Failing to revitalize the flexibility of the oxidised surface will allow failure mechanisms to continue under the surface sealant and will only act as a paint and brittle failure process will still propagate.

HER rejuvenator is a hydrocarbon enriched bitumen based liquid which contains a wide spectrum of rejuvenating agents and oxidation resistants' that when applied at ambient temperature to a bituminous surface will:

- Penetrate and seal micro cracks in the old oxidised surface thus improving permeability.
- Enhance the existing bitumen with a blend of naturally occurring pitch bitumens, maltene
 rich additive, oils and resins. The hydrocarbon enriched bitumen, also retards further
 oxidation and fatigue by approximately 5 times greater than normal refinery grade bitumes
- Increases the skid resistance immediately after application
- Shelf life in excess of 12 Months
- Timeous application will prevent aggregate loss
- Extend the replacement life of Roads, Runways and Parking areas considerably

Application:

HER rejuvenator is cold applied product, applied at surface temperatures ranging from 5°C. Under the correct conditions it can be applied at night.

The application rate of HER rejuvenator will depend on the texture of the existing surfaces to be treated :

- Smooth surfaces lower application rate e.g.. Old slurry surfaces
- Rough surfaces higher application rate e.g.. Stone seals and asphalt surfacing

Application rates vary between 0,4 and 0,6 litres per m².

If more than 0.6 litres per m^2 is required, apply in two applications allowing 48 hours between applications.

Before application, inspect existing surfaces thoroughly:

- Area where oil has spilt should be cleaned properly.
- Potholes and wide cracks must identified and repaired after rejuvenation.
- Areas of different texture should be assessed for variation of application.
- Care must be taken when applying in areas where there is existing concrete structures and kerbs.

HER rejuvenator is supplied in bulk for spraying in large areas where higher volumes are required. HER rejuvenator is also supplied in drums for labour intensive applications i.e., paint rollers and hand sprayers at approximately the same cost.

After application, HER rejuvenator requires 2 - 3 hours to dry sufficiently for use depending on weather conditions.

During this time, all vehicles and pedestrians must be kept off the area. Road markings should be applied as per normal bitumen surfaces.
